i) START NUMBER

Thank you for your entry. Your competition number is shown on the enclosed entry list. No discussion will be entered into regarding the seeding so please don't ring the organisers. If you think we've got it wrong, prove it on the day!

Anyone wishing to enter the 'AS Performance North of England Tarmacadam Championship' please speak to Mike Rowe who might be hanging around on the day of the rally. Permit Number is 3/2010.

Can all competitors make sure you are in croft by 08:00 on Saturday 2nd 2010

Please note anyone wanting turbos sealed must get to scrutineering early or wait until a slot becomes free

7. TIMETABLE

Saturday 2nd January 2010

Circuit gates will be opened at 05:30hrs

Noise Test, Scrutineering & Documentation from

06:00-08:30hrs ONLY by allotted times, please see time schedule.

Would cars proceeding to noise test please report to the service out control, 10 Minutes before due time at Noise test where door numbers will be issued before being told to proceed to noise, please see diagram.

8.ROUTE

The start of the event will be at Croft Race Circuit, Map ref. 93/293072 and the prize presentation will be at Croft Racing Circuit. 8 Special Stages of approx. 40 miles will comprise of 98% sealed surface.

10.NOISE

Excessive noise is not allowed at Croft Circuit, this includes harsh anti lag systems. Croft Circuit will be monitoring noise using their own sensitive metering system that is installed around the circuit. The Environmental Scrutineer and Judges of Fact will also be monitoring noise; they all have the power to report excessive noise including excessive and repetitive back firing. A possible penalty could be EXCLUSION.

12. AWARDS

Provisional and Final Results will be at the marquee in service area

This year we will be again presenting 2 special awards,

1. After supporting Northallerton auto club as safety officer for many years we will be awarding a Steve Easton spirit of the rally award for the sixth year in memory of Steve who sadly died
2. Victoria Garage (Richmond) Team Award. (To enter for this award you need to have 3 cars of different classes for a fee of £6 per team)

No competitor will be allowed to win more than one award. except for the above 2.

16. SERVICING

The service area is very restricted. Only one support/service vehicle will be allowed in the service area, Again this year it will be rigorously enforced so please don't try it on.

Service area coordinator at the entrance to the service area will be allowing ONE vehicle in with the rally car, you may park other additional vehicles in the car park near the grandstand, and walk into service area.

Please keep your service area to a minimum, if not you may be asked to reduce the area that you are utilizing.

Trailers will be allowed in the service area, but on the grass next to it for parking trailers.(see attached diagram)
Each competing car will return to the service area after every stage.

The service area is subject to a maximum speed limit of 10mph, The warming of brakes and tyres by bursts of acceleration within the confines of the service area is not allowed. Penalty for failing to comply will be exclusion.

18. CONTROLS AND TIMING (c)

Note! The area between the SSA and SSS will be Parc Ferme

Cars will be required to start at 30 second intervals.

You may be expected to wait 10 minutes between ATC and STC

All special stages will have a bogie time set at 75mph.

22. Lateness is reduced to 10 minutes. Controls will close 10 minutes after due time of arrival of the last car.

28. TYRES

Please note : Failing to stop immediately, to replace a wheel and tyre when a competitor gets a puncture will receive the penalty of exclusion.

For this reason a spare wheel that fits all 4 corners must be carried at all times, penalty for failing to comply will also be exclusion.

All marshals will be deemed "Judges of Fact" and will report infringements to the Clerk of the Course.

Slicks tyres will be attending the event on the day of the rally. Although he will have a selection of tyres available this will be limited, so if you require tyres please preorder, Tel: 0114 2470485

iii) NOISE, SCRUTINEERING & DOCUMENTATION

Cars may be unloaded from trailers on Saturday 2nd (see diagram). NO VEHICLE OTHER THAN RALLY CARS WILL BE ALLOWED across the race circuit towards noise

Noise test, Scrutineering and Documentation is at 06:00 to 08:30 on Saturday 02/01/10. Competitor's documentation sheet will be issued at noise test- this must be completed in every detail before your rally pack will be issued. Membership of Northallerton A.C. Ltd will be available at signing on (valid until the end of December 2010). Competitors who wish to apply for club membership are requested to call at documentation before noise to collect the appropriate forms and bring them with the appropriate fee when they return to sign on.

Competition numbers will be SUPPLIED by the ORGANISERS. A limited parts will be available - telephone AS Performance for specific requirements. Tel 0191 410 3770

Please note that door numbers must be attached to the door before entering the scrutineering area.

iv) MAIN CONTROLS

Competitors due time at MTC1 will be notified at signing-on, 1st competitor will leave MTC1 at 09:05hrs.

Auxiliary lights will be needed by all cars, if you wish to see where you are going. The last stages will be run in the dark.

vii) DAMAGE DECLARATIONS

viii) TRAILER PARKING

Trailers will be allowed in the service area but in the trailer parking area (see diagram). Please note LOCK your trailers.
